Anna Dornbos, 64, of St. Albans passed away Friday, February 10, 2017 at CAMC-Teays Valley after a courageous battle with breast cancer.

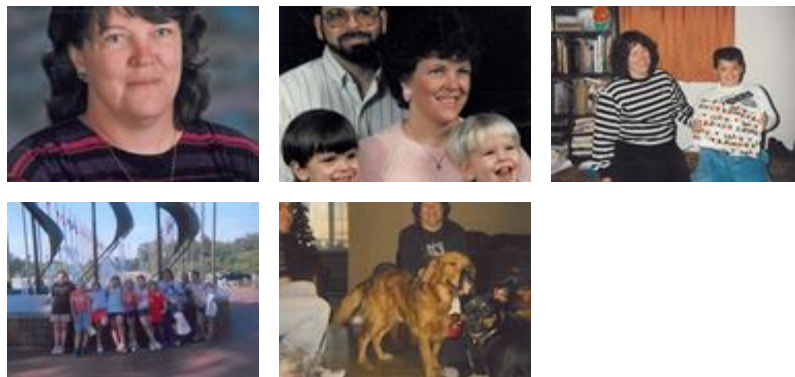

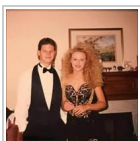
