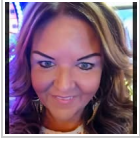
until then heaven just got a little sweeter. A service to celebrate her life will follow at a later date.

In lieu of flowers memorial donations can be made in Aubrey's name to the Putnam County Animal Shelter 12908 Charleston Road, Red House, WV.

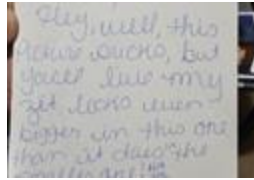

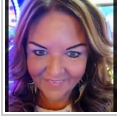
