Barion Ray "Barney" Casebolt, 86, of St. Albans, departed this life April 30, 2018 in St. Mary's Hospital, Huntington after a long illness.

He was born on January 12, 1932 in Riverside, Kanawha County, to the late James E. Casebolt, Sr., and Carrie Opal Ramsey Casebolt. Barney was the youngest of four children.

He was a graduate of Poca High School, Class of 1949 and attended Morris Harvey College, West Virginia State College, and Corcoran School of Art in Washington, D.C. After high school, he was employed at American Viscose Corporation in Nitro and Carbide Tech Center in South Charleston. His army service, 1952-1954, was in Germany. 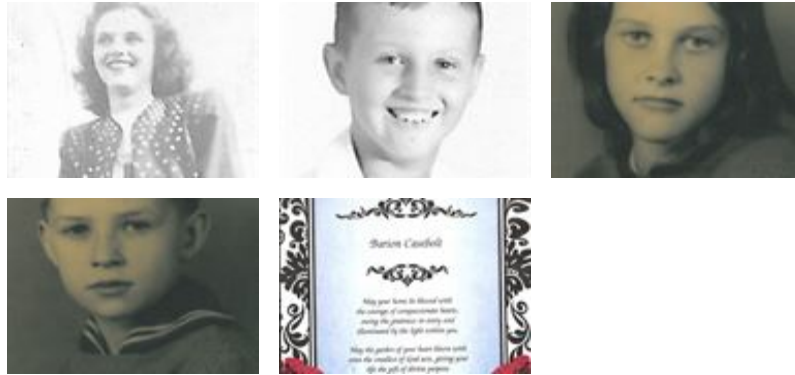
