Whether it was a midget league, middle, or high school game he made them all while cheering his teammates on with his own pep talk versions of “get your head in the game if you want to win” and “keep it on a swivel”.

Branden was a 2008 graduate of Hurricane High School, member of Teays Valley Missionary Baptist Church, and a general lover of people especially his beloved nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his maternal grandfather, Gifford D. Webb, maternal grandparents, Frank and Josphine Stewart, as well as other family members.
