Calvin Lee Hatfield, 85, of Hurricane passed away Thursday, May 20, 2015 at CAMC- Teays Valley following a short illness.

Born February 12, 1930 in Williamson, he was a son of the late Charles Bronson and Mary Reid Hatfield. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Administration from Marshall University in 1952 where he also was a founding member of the Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity. Calvin was also a board member of the Putnam County Service District for 28 years. He was co-owner and manager of the area ShortStop Markets in the late 1970's as well as the Gino's Pizza, Hurricane. Recently he had been managing Hatfield Properties.

Surviving are his wife, Freda Jane Hatfield; son, Dr. Philip B. Hatfield (Alaynna Janco) of Teays Valley; sister, Rachel Runyon Hatfield of Columbus, NC; grandchildren, Ryan, Courtney and Kristen Hatfield; step-granddaughter, Haley Janco; great-grandchildren, Dominic, Roman and Elias.
