Carl D. Frame, 73 of St. Albans passed away Thursday, August 27, 2015 at Golden Living, Glasgow.

Born February 16, 1942 at Crab Orchard to the late Ernest Don and Inez Ada Argerbright Frame. He was also preceded in death by a brother, Clarence Lee Frame.

Carl started in the restaurant business at the age of 14 working for John Smiley at Smiley's, St. Albans and he also worked at BBF. Carl and a friend bought into the Gino's Franchise and this started his career as owner and operator of Dino's Restaurant and Donnie's Restaurant in South Charleston, Kin Folks, Tropical Pools, River's Edge Restaurant from Nov. 1986 – 2004. He also operated the Capital Cafeteria 1994 – 2006 and the Columbia Gas Cafeteria for a short time.

He also enjoyed coaching his sons, St. Albans Youth baseball and basketball teams from 1974 to 1994.

Surviving is his loving wife of 52 years Sharon Goodall Frame, daughter, Kelli Blankenship (Allen) of St. Albans; sons, Carlan D. 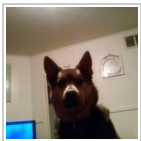
