Carolyn Lee Wilcoxon of Eleanor, WV born July 11, 1944 went home to be with the Lord on March 16, 2026.

Carolyn was the daughter of the late Clara Moody and step daughter of the late Edward R. Moody. She was also preceded in death by her loving husband, Rev. Clifford Wilcoxon; sister, Pauline Moody Bird; niece, Denise Pennington; special brothers in-law: C.H. Bird, Vernon Bird and Wendell Wilcoxon; and cousins: Leo and Dorsey Dollen.

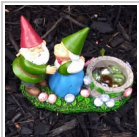
