Chad O'Dell, 46, of Hurricane, WV passed away on Sunday, October 27, 2018 at Hubbard Hospice House.

Chad, born on December 31, 1971, in Montgomery WV, was the son of Harold and Terry O'Dell of Canvas, WV. He grew up in Summersville, WV and graduated from Nicholas County High School in 1990. He was a veteran of the United States Navy. He attended West Virginia University and graduated with B.A. degrees in history and economics in 1998. He was a brother of the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity. Chad was employed as a Senior Account Representative at CleaRESULT Consulting, Inc.

He is survived by his wife, Rebecca O'Dell; children, Emma O'Dell and Nathan O'Dell; parents, Harold and Terry O'Dell of Canvas, WV; brothers, Wesley O'Dell (Anna) of Summersville, WV and Brandon O'Dell (Rolf) of Amsterdam, Netherlands; and grandmother Jo O'Dell of Fayetteville, WV. As well as many extended family members and friends.

Chad was a dedicated father and husband with a fun-loving nature. 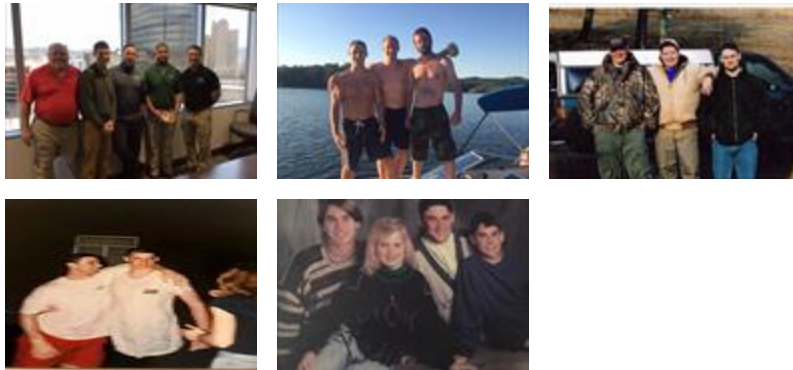

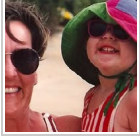
