Charles Edward Six Sr., 77 of Scott Depot passed away Monday March 27, 2017 at Hubbard Hospice House, West, South Charleston surrounded by his family.

Born November 8, 1939 in Big Chimney, Charlie was the only child of the late James Milroy Six and Louie Ardith Reynolds Six.

Charlie served his country with the United States Air Force, his love of flying continued into adulthood as he pursued an amateur pilot license.
