Charles Leslie "Dick" Stowers, Jr., 87 of St. Albans went home to be with the Lord on Friday, September 5, 2014 at his home with his family by his side.

He was born February 24, 1927 in Charleston, West Virginia, a son of Charles L. and Thelma E. Burgess Stowers. He was also preceded in death by a sister, Patricia Stowers Walton; brothers, James F., Robert R. and Paul G. Stowers.

Dick was a retired Captain for the Charleston Fire Department with 24 years and 3 months of service. He was a former salesman for Peerless Block & Brick and Rhodes Brick & Block. He served his country in World War II with the Merchant Marine during 1944–1946.
