He was a veteran of the Air Force and worked on steam engines until diesel engines took over. He worked at Union Carbide for 30+ years. He also worked at Lester Construction Company in Hurricane. He married Kathleen Allen Rollyson in 1952 and she predeceased him in 2011.

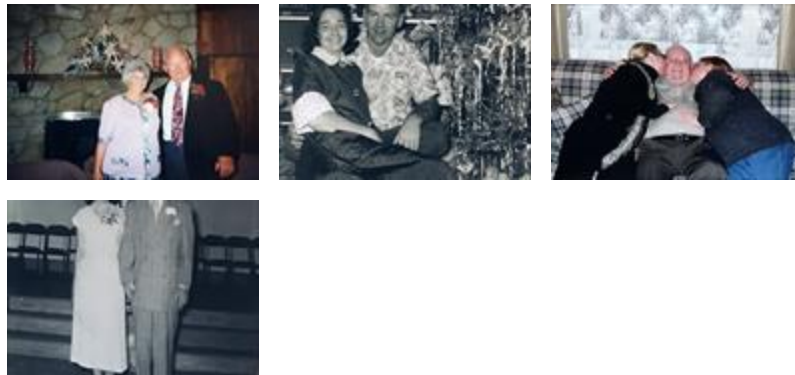
