



## Clayton W. Larck Jr.

August 11, 1952 - October 3, 2013

Clayton W. “Bugs” Larck, Jr., 61 of St. Albans lost his battle with brain cancer on Thursday, October 3, 2013 at his residence.

Clayton was born August 11, 1952 in St. Albans, West Virginia to the late Clayton W. Larck, Sr. and Dolly Irene Hensley Larck. He was also preceded in death by his sister, Rhoena Larck.

Clayton was a US Army veteran having served during the Vietnam War as SP4 with the 82nd Airborne Division, stationed at Fort Bragg, NC.

He was a retired member of the United Mine Workers America, District 17 where he worked as a construction miner and head of security for the UMWA President Cecil Roberts with 38 years of service. He was also vice-president of Local Union 1582 for 28 years, Charleston.

Clayton also owned and operated Larck Excavation and was responsible for the building of many roads and bridges throughout the area.

Clayton was an avid motorcycle rider and classic car owner. He was a founding member of the “Brothers of the Wheel” motorcycle club where he instilled the true meaning of brotherhood and dedication to helping those in need wherever he was. He served as Scout and Sgt. at Arms for many years.

He is survived by his loving wife of 34 years, Judy Larck and his son, William Clayton "Wink" Larck both of St. Albans; sisters, Rosie Nelson of St. Augustine, FL., Goldie Carmichael of Mansfield, OH and Linda Canankamp of Columbus, OH.; brothers, Earl Larck of Mansfield, OH and Donnie Larck of Delaware, OH.
