Crystal Leone Starcher Newhouse, 96 of St. Albans went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, April 11, 2018 at her residence.

She was born in Reedy, Roane County to the late Stephen and Ada Young Starcher. She was preceded in death by her husband of 57 years, Harry Francis Newhouse and her oldest daughter, Donna Frances Newhouse Hamon, just 3 weeks ago.

Leone who lived in Sissonville, WV from 1939 to 1996 was a member of her community church Humphrey's United Methodist Church.

She loved to sew, arrange flowers and cook, especially for her family. When in high school she worked for the Spencer WV newspaper where among other things, she set type. She and Harry, owned and managed Newhouse Exxon in Sissonville until their retirement in 1980.

In 1996 she and Harry moved to St. Albans where she made her home these last 16 years with Donna and Avas.
