She was also the primary caregiver for her widowed mother for almost 20 years. She took everything in stride and even found time for her numerous nieces and nephews and other extended family members who loved her dearly.

Jenny always answered "I love you" with "I love you da dostest" which she picked up from great-granddaughter Laney when she was little. She was known as Gigi to her great-grandchildren and often called the energizer bunny because she could be found playing with the children. She was known to her grandchildren and even their friends as "Little Mamaw". She will be greatly missed by all who knew her.

Jenny graduated from Washington District High School in 1945. She was a devout Christian attending Southwest Church of God, West Albans Church of God, and Teays Valley Church of God during her lifetime.
