Dana Lewis Curry, of St. Albans, W.Va., passed away Sunday, December 11, 2011, in North Carolina. During the previous eight years, he had resided in Orlando, Florida, and recently had relocated to Mint Hill, N.C. Born September 2, 1924, he was the son of the late Soder and Cordie Curry. He also was preceded in death by his wife, Betty Curry; son, Keith Curry; two brothers, Meredith "Todd" Curry and Tommy Curry; and sister, Marcella Eskew. Mr. Curry was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Cannon Company, 21st Infantry, 24th Division Army of the United States of America.
