Daniel Olen Dean, 74, of Charleston, passed away Wednesday, May 17, 2017, after a long illness.

He was born on April 29, 1943 in Morgantown, West Virginia, to the late Olen and Mary Sullivan Dean. Daniel was also preceded in death by his brother, Michael S. Dean.

Danny is survived by his wife of 50 years, Phyllis, sons, Jamie Dean, of Hickory, NC and Michael (Cindy) of Hurricane; two grandchildren, Peyton and Ryan.

He attended St. Francis Grade School, McKinley Jr. High and graduated from St. Albans High School in 1961. Danny was a graduate from Gordon Military Academy in 1963 and Marshall University in 1971. He worked for Union Carbide, Lyondell and retired from Bayer Corporation in 2004. He was also a 30 year member of the 130th Air Lift Wing of the West Virginia Air National Guard and a Veteran of Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

Danny was active in his community through St. Albans Little League, Senior League and Midget League football. He was an active member of the St. Albans Jaycees. He served as President of the Catholic War Veterans and Knights of Columbus, both with St. Francis Parish. His hobbies included golf,

bowling, spending time with friends and family, and Thundering Herd sports.

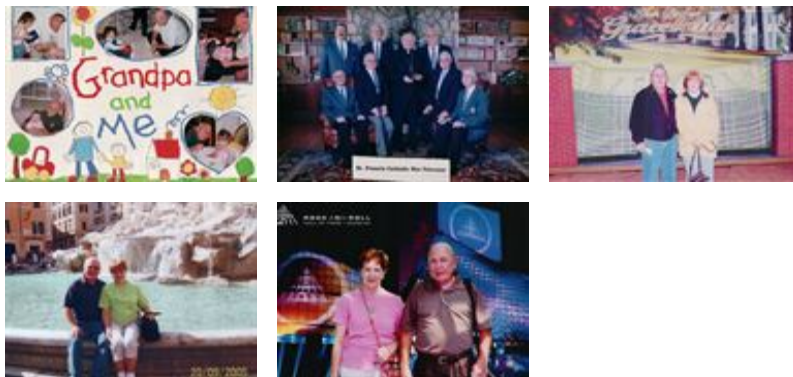
