David Pence, a Man of God, a legend, a giant among the God servants passed away Tuesday November 3, 2015. He would like to let you know that his work here is done. He received a call he couldn't refuse, for an appointment from which he will not be returning. His new mission takes him to a wonderful place where he will be worshipping the Lord like he did his entire life, preaching, playing golf and watching ball games to his heart's content. He will be socializing with godly people who will make him laugh and feel loved, who will recognize and value his noble character, people who will say only good words to him. He left detailed instructions for his wife Krystyna to celebrate his mission here, which has now been completed.

David graduated from Charleston High School, Tennessee Temple University and Bethany Theological Seminary. He was a Baptist pastor for 45 years and although "retired" for the last five years, David was never off-duty, helping and loving people.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Joyce Pence and parents, Leonard and Jewel Pence.

David is survived by his second wife, Krystyna; sons, Randy and Douglas; step-children, Alina, René and Oliver and five grandchildren.

Funeral service will be held at 1:00 PM Saturday November 7, 2015 at Grace Baptist Temple, St. Albans with Pastor Brian Dean, Pastor Gary Trout and Pastor Mike Whisman officiating. Entombment will follow in Graceland Memorial Park, South Charleston.
