Dean Turkett, 66, of Hurricane, WV died Friday, May 23, 2014.

Born August 12, 1947 in Schenectady, NY, he was a son of the late Huel Augustus and Shirley Emily Sparrow Turkett.

Dean was an industrial salesman for many years, ultimately forming and operating his own company, Superliner. He was a 1974 graduate of Morris Harvey College, Charleston, WV, served his country with the United States Air Force and was a former member of Sleepy Hollow Golf Club. His love of sports began early in his life and followed him through his years in junior college. Because of this love he was a coach and one of the founders of the former Putnam County YBOA. Animals, family and friends were always held close to his heart.

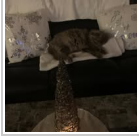
