Densil C. Neumeyer, 82, beloved husband of Ollie Elizabeth “Liz” Neumeyer, of Hurricane, went peacefully home to our Lord after a long and courageous battle with Parkinson’s Disease, on Friday, June 9, 2017, at Hubbard House Hospice West, with her by his side.

The son of the late Bryan Eugene and Martha Chapman Neumeyer, Densil was born in, and a lifelong resident of, Hurricane, graduating from Hurricane High School in 1952. After honorably serving in the US Army, he went on to a successful career as a laborer and carpenter at the Nickel Plant (Special Metals) in Huntington, retiring after 33 years in 1993. As well as being a member of the Moose Lodge 868 in St. Albans, Densil enjoyed a good game of golf with his friends, but his truest passion was cheering on his WVU Mountaineers. Along with Liz, who shares his Mountaineer spirit, he leaves countless special memories shared with so many family members and friends -whether in Morgantown tailgating, or from a front row seat in his favorite chair- watching his Mountaineers play ball.
