March 20, 1953 - April 6, 2017

Denver Allen Jordan, 64, passed away April 6, 2017, after a short illness.

Born March 20, 1953 in St. Albans, Denver was the son of the late Arnold Joseph "Rookie", and Pearl Frances Jordan. He is also preceded in death by his brother Ray Jordan.

Denver graduated St. Albans High School in 1971, was an Eagle Scout out of Troop #48, and earned a master's degree from WVU in Computer Science. He also served his country in the Air Force.

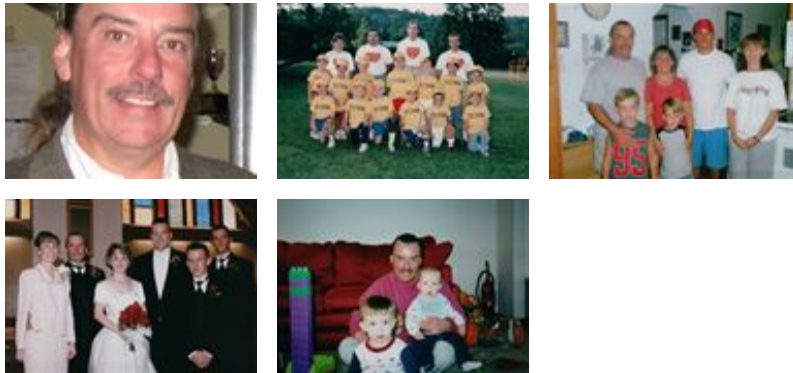
