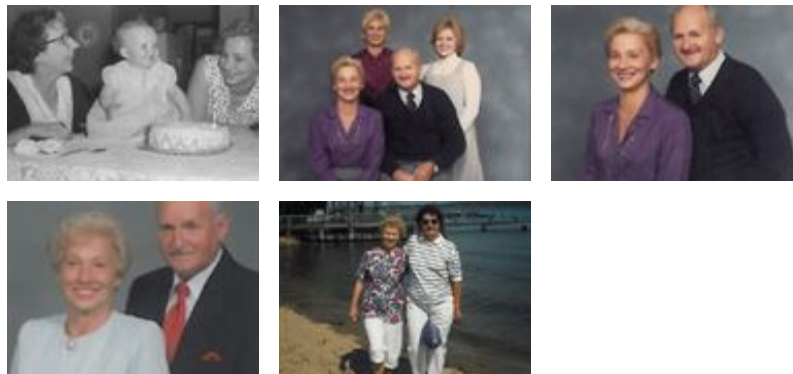


“ *Kim,
