Donald C. Pittman, CLU ChFC, 73, of Hurricane, was called to his eternal home Monday, April 7, 2014 at Hubbard Hospice House Charleston.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Tracy Ann Pittman and his brother, Rodney E. Pittman.

Born March 21, 1941 in New Orleans, LA, Don moved to West Virginia in 1995. He graduated from Louisiana State University with a degree in Architecture, and worked as an architect and in the construction business until he joined New York Life in 1984 in New Orleans, LA.
