Dorothy Jean "Jeannie" Schneider, 73, of Hurricane, WV, died on Sunday, May 25, at her home. Her family was at her side.

Jeannie was born in Caney, Kansas, on October 26, 1940, to William Calvin Cooper and Rita Jean Cooper. She grew up in Independence, KS, attended Independence Community College, and graduated from Kansas State University. After teaching high school home economics for 2 years in Paola, KS, she attended Purdue University, receiving her master's degree. The girl from a small town in Kansas traveled the world with her husband. When faced with hearing loss that curtailed her teaching, she didn't give up hope but changed careers, passing the CPA exam on her first try. She also became a Certified Estate Planner, and spent most of her career with the Ross, Langan & McKendree accounting firm in McLean, VA. She was a long-time resident of Annandale, VA.

Jeannie battled cancer with courage and wanted to comfort her loved ones even as her days ran out. She is survived by her loving husband of 48 years, George Schneider, of Hurricane; her daughter Christine Shaffer, her husband Gregory Shaffer, and their children Emma and Lauren Shaffer; her son Calvin Schneider, his wife Laurie Aaronson, and their children Talia and Rex Schneider; her mother Rita Cooper of Independence, KS; and her four sisters, Anita Foster of Olathe, KS, Sarah Noyes of Olathe, KS, Joan Hardy of Independence, KS, and Honora Bracken of Arlington, TX.
