Elmer William Robinson, 92 of St. Albans passed away Thursday, October 20, 2016 at Hubbard Hospice House West, South Charleston.

Born October 5, 1924 in St. Albans, Elmer was the son of the late James Henry and Stella Odessa Torman Robinson. He was also preceded in death by his sisters, Ardellia Robinson and Christina Hale.

He was a retired instrument fitter from Union Carbide Corp. with 38 years of service. He was known by all his fellow workers as "Robbie". We never knew him to have an enemy; he was loved by everyone that knew him. Elmer told a joke to everyone he met and loved everyone.

He served in the United States Army for 2 ½ years in the infantry as a machine gunner and served on the front lines in the European Theatre; where he was wounded twice. He came home on February 18, 1946 and married his only sweetheart, Joyce Terry on May 24, 1946; who loved him dearly and they had a wonderful life together for 70 ½ years.

He was a member of the Washington Masonic Lodge No. 58 A.F & A.M. of St. Albans, which he joined in 1959 and was a 32 degree mason of the Scottish Rite of Charleston. He was also a member of Robinson United Methodist Church of St. Albans

He had two sons, Dorsey (deceased) and Ronnie who came back home when Elmer got sick and cared for him in every way. Also survived by his grandchildren, Brady and wife, Jackie, Lonnie and wife, Tracy, Amy and Cathi; great grandchildren, Savana, Austin, Tom, Tyler and Rowan; two great great grandchildren and sister, Wonetia Thompson of Hurricane.

Funeral service will be held at 2:00 pm Sunday, October 23, 2106 at Bartlett-Chapman Funeral Home, St. Albans with Pastor Steve Inman officiating. Entombment with masonic rites will be in Cunningham Memorial Park, St. Albans.
