Ennis S. Wyrick, 68, of Hurricane passed away Tuesday, February 17, 2015 at his residence.

He was a graduate of Hurricane High School, attended WV State College and completed advanced studies in electronics and computer sciences and application at schools in New York, Boston, Cincinnati, Nashville, and Raleigh, NC. He was a Vietnam Era US Army veteran and was a past member of the VFW of Hurricane and the Moose Lodges of St. Albans, Nitro, and Raleigh.
