Eugene Frank Karcheski, 84, of Cross Lanes, passed away on Monday, November 14, 2016, at CAMC Memorial Hospital, Charleston.

He was born on July 18, 1932, in Scranton, PA to the late Eugene and Angela Karcheski. Gene graduated from Scranton Central High School, Keystone Junior College, and Penn State Extension School.
