Finley Dunlap Seldomridge, 83 of St. Albans passed away Friday September 15, 2017.

Finley was born in Hinton, WV and was the son of the late Lawrence Newt Seldomridge and Mae Dunlap Seldomridge. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his wife, Jean Seldomridge and granddaughter, Megan Gutierrez.

Finley was a graduate of St. Albans High School, Class of 1952. Following graduation, Finley went to West Virginia University, where he participated in the marching band. He graduated from WVU in 1956 as a Pharmacist.

He began his career at Trivillian's Pharmacy on Quarrier Street, which he later purchased and operated as Finley's Pharmacy until 1977. He then worked for St. Francis Hospital Pharmacy and retired from Rite Aid on February 1, 2008, exactly 50 years from when he began his career.

Finley's love for the West Virginia Mountaineers remained throughout his life as he cheered them on during football and basketball seasons. He had a passion for golf, loved working his yard and enjoyed many styles of music. He was also a member of St. Andrew United Methodist Church, St. Albans.
