Francis Joseph "Frank" Augenstein, 68, of St. Albans died Thursday, December 3, 2015 at Thomas Memorial Hospital, South Charleston, following complications of COPD with his family surrounding him.

Born March 22, 1947 in Parkersburg, Frank was a son of the late Joseph and Ethel Augenstein. He was also preceded in death by his first wife, and mother of his children, Donna Lou Augenstein; his brother, Chester Augenstein and his son-in-law, Jack Hill as well as his granddaughter, Campbell Elizabeth Williams.
