Frank X. Schirtzinger, 83, of Hurricane, passed away Saturday, January 23, 2016 at home.

Born June 2, 1932 in Columbus OH, he was a son of the late Albert and Frances Schirtzinger. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his brothers Bill Schirtzinger and Jack Schirtzinger and sister Susie Baumann.

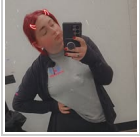
