Frankie Caroline Cecil Hancock McClellan went home to be with her Lord on Saturday, April 17, 2021.

Frankie accepted Jesus as her Savior at the age of 13 years at a community revival. She did not follow in Baptism until 1976 by Rev. Mickey Wick at Judson Baptist Church where she attended regularly and served in the ABWM, Bible School, Sunday School Teacher, cemetery committee, sang in the choir and prayer circle chain.

She was born December 10, 1941 to Frank and Annie Cecil in Christiansburg, VA. She was preceded in death by her parent; two sisters, Anne Moore and Dorotha Epperly; her first husband of 26 years, Charles Hancock and second husband of 2 ½ years, Howard McClellan.
