Fred Daniel “Dan” Fizer, 81, of Scott Depot passed away on Tuesday, October 23, 2018, after a long illness.

Dan was born July 23, 1937 in Quick, to the late Kerney and Mary Fizer. Dan served in the Army, and the Army National Guard shortly after graduating from Elkview High School. He worked for Carbide before becoming a realtor, where he loved serving people and helping them buy or sell their homes.
