Frederick Lee “Fast Freddie” Null, 46, of Hurricane, passed away Monday, May 18, 2015.

Born September 29, 1968 in South Charleston, he was a son of Ronna Earl Null, and Janet Carol Johnson.

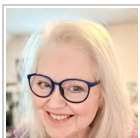
