



## Gerald Edward Garrett

August 19, 1938 - February 1, 2025

Gerald Edward Garrett 86, of Scott Depot, WV passed away on February 1, 2025 after a long battle with Parkinson's Disease.

The Garrett family originated in the Isle of Man and later settled in Colorado to pursue silver and gold mining.

Ed was born in Denver, Colorado on August 19, 1938 to the late Lewis and Elsie Garrett. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his first wife, Carolyn Jo Garrett; and brothers: Robert and Raymond Garrett.

After graduating from the University of Denver with a degree in Chemical Engineering, Ed started his career with Union Carbide in Charleston, WV, with later stints in New Orleans, LA and Houston, TX. After retiring from Carbide, Ed worked at John Brown and Clarion. In his later years, he traveled the world and had more time for his hobbies of photography, playing bridge, baking, grilling, fishing, camping, visiting national parks, and spending time with friends and family.
