Glenn Richards, Jr., 59, of Scott Depot passed away Wednesday, January 13, 2021 at CAMC General Hospital following complications of a stroke.

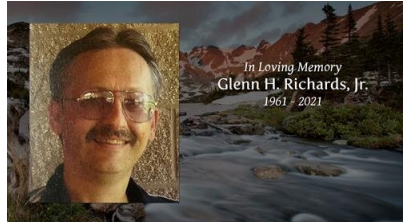

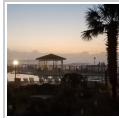
