Glenn Webb 65, of Hurricane WV passed away on March 8, 2014 at Cabell Huntington Hospital.

He was the youngest son of the late Ballard and Mary Vaughn Webb in Dwale KY. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a grandson, Bryson Lee Blankenship-Webb, and several brothers and sisters.
