Glenna Agatha Worley, 75, of Hurricane, WV, passed away peacefully on December 19, 2015, following a short battle with cancer.

Born October 3, 1940, in Bluefield, WV, Agatha was the daughter of the late Edward and Ocie Bailey.

She was also preceded in death by her husband of 49 years, A. H. "Buddy" Worley Jr., and one brother, Gene Bailey.

Agatha is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Michael and Leah Worley of Winfield, WV; two granddaughters, whom she loved dearly, Hannah and Kristen Worley also of Winfield; her sister-in-law, Margaret Bailey of Deltona, FL; and several nieces and nephews.

Prior to moving to Hurricane, Agatha and her husband lived a majority of their lives in Parkersburg, WV, where Agatha worked 20 years for Dils Department Store as a beauty consultant for Estee Lauder. Known for her vibrant and outgoing personality, Agatha was an active participant in several community organizations. While living in Parkersburg, she was a member of the Vienna Women's Club, Beta Sigma Phi and Alpha Delta Master.

Later, moving to Carmel, IN, Agatha continued her life-long career in the

cosmetics industry and was well known as a talented make-up artist. Finally, in 2004, Agatha and her husband settled in Hurricane to be closer to their children. While living in Hurricane she continued her activities as a member of the Teays Valley Newcomers and Neighbors club. In addition to the Parkersburg chapter, she was also a member of the Charleston chapter of Beta Sigma Phi and was recognized as a 50-year member. Agatha never knew a stranger, and no matter what city she lived in, she was always blessed with special friendships that she cherished throughout her lifetime.

Funeral services for Agatha will be 1:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 23rd, at Chapman Funeral Home in Hurricane. Visitation will be conducted from 6 to 8 p.m. Tuesday, December 22nd, and again two hours prior to the service. A private family burial will be held the following day at Monte Vista Park Cemetery in Bluefield.
