Harold DePue passed away at Select Specialty Hospital in Charleston, WV on Saturday, March 18, 2017 at the age of 70.

Harold is predeceased by his parents, Norman and Myrtle Carpenter DePue, as well as a brother Gary DePue and a son Robbie DePue.

Harold is survived by his lovely wife Judy of 17 years. Also surviving is a brother, Bryan DePue of Spencer, WV; daughter Tina DePue Bell, of Fort Mill, SC; stepson, Chad Boothe of Pinch, WV; three grandchildren, Peyton Skiles, Conner Skiles and Paige Bell; step-granddaughter, Brooke Boothe.

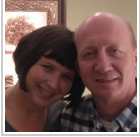
