Harold Bertland Reynolds, known to many as Sarge, of St. Albans went home to be with his Lord and Savior on August 9, 2014.

He was born in Marne on July 2, 1918 and was a graduate of the 1938 class of Clendenin High School. Harold retired from B.F. Shaw at the Alloy plant and was a member of the Pipefitters Local 625 for 62 years. He was also a 32 degree Master Mason of Lodge No. 158 A.F. & A.M. Chelyan and served in Panama for 5 years in the Army Air Corp. Harold was a member of First Baptist Church, St. Albans.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Thomas Staten and Naomi Neff Reynolds; brother Howard and sisters Louie Six, Lucille Six and infant sister Lorena.
