



## Harry W. Ray

December 23, 1947 - June 30, 2017

God called another angel home, June 30th, 2017. Harry Webster Ray, 69, born December 23, 1947 in Scott Depot, and a lifelong resident of Putnam County, died suddenly after a short stay in the hospital.

Harry is survived by his wife, Sue of 49 years, residing in Winfield.

Harry was preceded in death, by his father, Harry Webster Ray, Sr. and mother, Myrtle Cora Johnson Ray; brothers, Manuel Ray of Eleanor and James Johnson of Ohio.

Harry leaves behind his wife, Victoria Sue Windon Ray; two daughters, Stephanie Glandon of Eleanor & Leslie Hanna and her husband, Stephen Aaron of Winfield; a sister, Cynthia Frazier and her husband, Jim of Fraziers Bottom; a brother, Gary Ray and his wife, Cindy of Oak Hill; three grandchildren, Kaleb Webster Glandon, Emily Lauren Glandon and Lillian Victoria Hanna as well as a host of nieces & nephews. Harry's grandchildren were the light of his life and family meant everything to him.

Harry was a devout Christian and a member of the former Winfield Community Church.

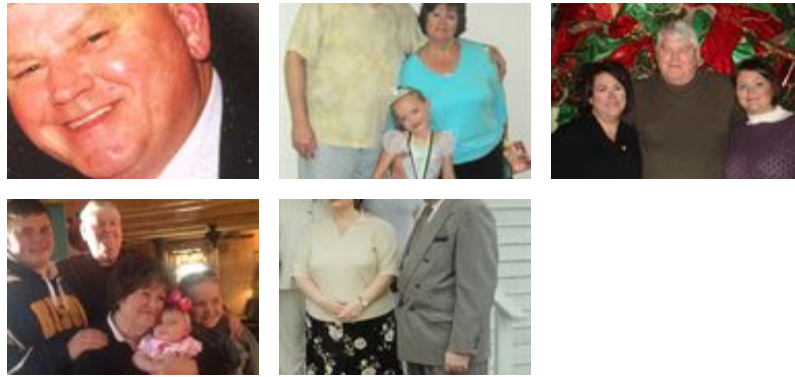
