Herbert Hoover May, 89, of St. Albans went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, June 24, 2018 at Hubbard Hospice House, South Charleston.

Hoover was a 1947 graduate of St. Albans High School. He was a veteran of the Korean War serving in the Air Force. He retired from Union Carbide Tech Center in 1982 after 35 years of service.

During his retirement years he enjoyed farming, golfing and most of all his family.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 48 years, Peggy Ann Kirby May; his father and mother, Ben and Nora May; brothers, Danny, Paul, Charlie, Jim and Glen; sisters, Ruby May Jarrett, Ruth May Bryant and Betty May McClure.

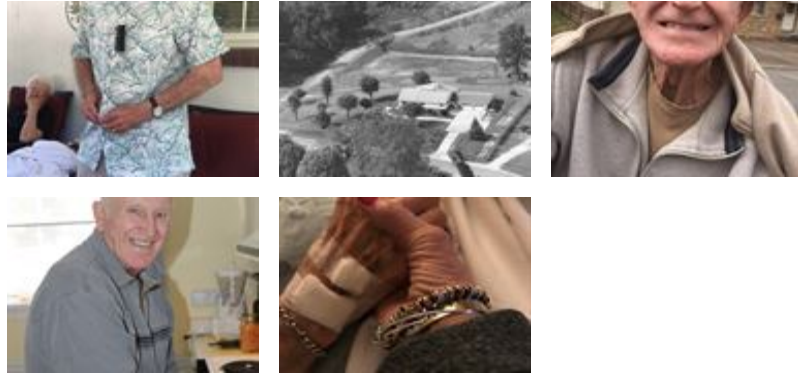
