



Howard Kenneth Snodgrass

Howard Kenneth Snodgrass, 99, of St. Albans, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, September 14, 2013 at home, surrounded by family.

Born August 11, 1914 in Kanawha County, he was a son of the late Blair and Virgie Snodgrass. He was also preceded in death by his loving wife of 74 years, Virginia Snodgrass; son, Howard Snodgrass, Jr.; daughter, Sandra Hoke; one brother and two sisters.

Howard was always respected for his work ethic. He was a family man who provided well for his family. He spent his early years working for the coal industry, Naval Ordnance and Monsanto. In the early 1960's, he became an agent of Nationwide Insurance. He retired in 1976 to Ft. Myers, FL. He and Virginia returned to West Virginia in 1994.

He and Virginia enjoyed traveling throughout the United States after their retirement. They were always a great support to their children, and both will be missed very much. He enjoyed listening to the sermons of Rev. Billy Graham and never missed an opportunity to watch him.

Howard is survived by his sons, Randall Snodgrass of Brooklyn, NY and Stephen Snodgrass and his wife, Sheila of Teays Valley; daughters, Sharon Alligood and her husband, Gene of Washington, NC, Patricia Gandee and companion, Butch Kennedy of St. Albans and Lorri Snodgrass of Charleston. He is also survived by nine grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
