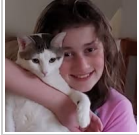

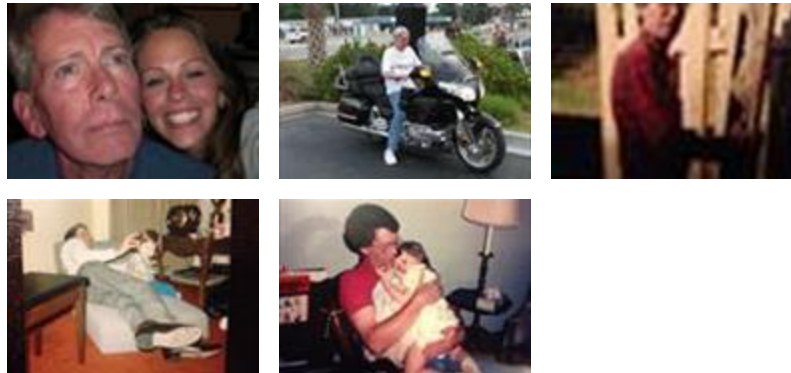

I trust that you will ask God to be present with your family during this time. His presence in our lives at all times is the best quality we will ever experience.

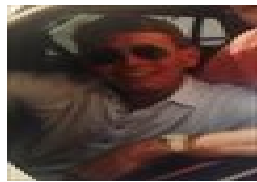
