James Paul “Jim” Clark, 88, of St. Albans, passed away peacefully Sunday, April 8, 2018 at Broadmore Assisted Living, Hurricane, WV.

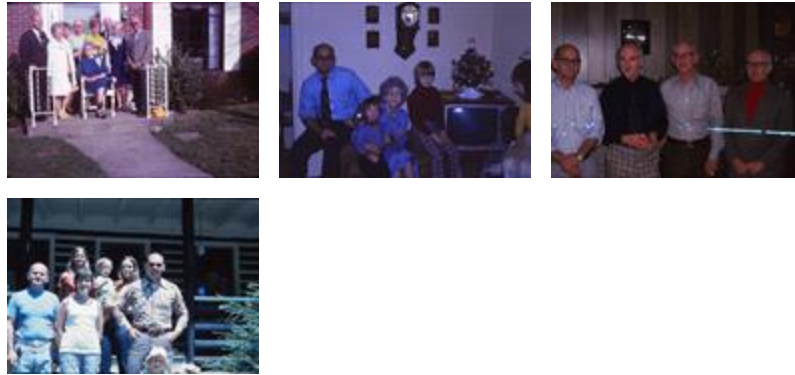

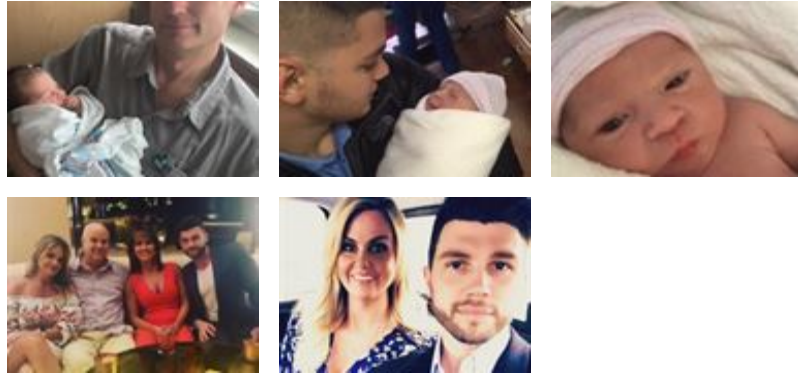

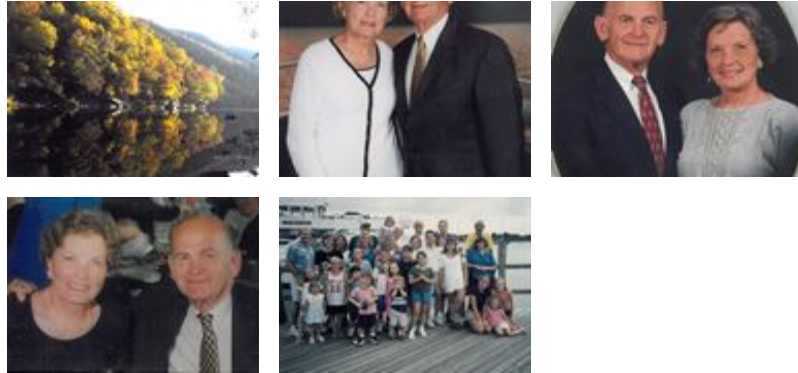
