Judge James Lee Thompson, 101, passed away peacefully at his home on May 24, 2022.

He was born to the late William E. and Rose Anna Dorothy Queck Thompson in Hurricane WV on January 6, 1921.

Judge Thompson was also preceded in death by his wife, Eloise Erwin Thompson, and daughter, Marsha L. Stewart.

Judge Thompson was retired from the 29th Judicial Circuit, was a life-long resident and dedicated member of First Baptist Church of Hurricane, WVU Law graduate, and proudly served his country in combat during World War II in the US Army.
