Jane Elizabeth McKinley, 86 of Scott Depot, formerly of St. Albans passed away Sunday May 19, 2013 at CAMC Teays Valley, Hurricane.

Born June 10, 1926 in Paterson, New Jersey, Jane was the daughter of the late Russell and Frieda Twist. In addition to her parents, she was also preceded in death by her husband, David Lee McKinley and daughter, Janet Villalobos.
