Jean Evelyn Keeling Brown, 84 of South Charleston passed away Monday March 23, 2015.

She is survived by her husband, Gene Brown; children, Ken Brown of Vienna, WV, Sandra Brown and husband Ralph Abato of New Britain, CT, and Scott Brown and wife Whitney of St. Albans; seven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren; brothers Harold "Boots" and Ray Keeling, and sister Lucille Wallace.

She was preceded in death by her parents Ross Franklin and Mamie Hodges Keeling, brother, Bill Keeling and sister, Virginia "Ginger" King.

Jean was born in Hurricane on July 1, 1930. Her family moved to Hinton and then Pickaway, WV where she spent most of her childhood and teenage years. After graduating from Union High, she attended the Charleston School of Commerce and began attending Fifth Avenue Church of God in South Charleston where she met her husband, Gene.
