Jim McCoy, 84, lifelong resident of St. Albans passed away Thursday, December 26, 2013 at Hubbard Hospice House, Charleston, after a brief illness.

He was born June 3, 1929 at Ronceverte, West Virginia the son of the late Charles William and Mabel Abrams McCoy. Jim married Mary Estelle Yearago on June 3, 1949. Mary preceded him in death in 2008 after 58 years. He was also preceded in death by his two sons, David Arland McCoy and James R. McCoy, Jr., sisters; Grace Carden and Mary Jane Wise, brother, Clarence McCoy.
