Jimmy B. Grant, 81, of Hurricane, WV, passed away peacefully on June 9, 2025, at Holzer Medical Center in Gallipolis, OH, after an extended illness.

He was born June 7, 1944 to the late Mervin Allen and Vonda Irene Grant. In addition to his parents, Jimmy was preceded in death by his sisters: Ima McDaniel, Shirley Whitt, Patty Lewis, and Diane Persinger.
