August 25, 1928 - February 26, 2015

Joe Hill Hatcher, 86, of Winfield, passed away February 26, 2015 at CAMC Teays Valley Hospital.

Joe was born August 25, 1928, in Pilot Mountain, NC, and was a son of the late George Mosby and Nannie Eliza Hill Hatcher. He served his country in the Korean War as a member of the United States Army. Joe was a retired mechanic, and in his 50 year career he worked for Hennis Freight Lines in Winston Salem, NC, Chemical Leaman Tank Lines in Institute, and was a member of the Teamsters Local Union #175. Joe was also a member of the Kanawha Valley #36 AF&AM Lodge.

Joe is survived by his loving wife of 59 years, Norma Wymer Hatcher; his brother, JD Hatcher of High Point, NC; and several nieces, nephews, and extended family members.
