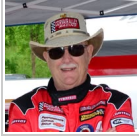

As an older person I always read the obits just to make sure I am not in them. This morning I got a shock as I recognized the name: John Addington. At first I wasn't sure as I would not have recognized him today but reading further, I knew it was him.

Fifty-three years ago, I returned from Vietnam and my then wife with two kids and I rented a trailer in St. Albans as we had no other place to live. Our next-door neighbors were a young couple about the same age as us also with two kids. He was a young West Virginia State Trooper. It was John Addington, his wife Bobbie, a son Tony and daughter Angie.

We became friends for a time but as life moved on we moved out to a house and John was transferred to a more southern county near Huntington which escapes me at the moment.

The next year me, my then wife Rosalinde (who also passed last year) and the kids spent Thanksgiving Day with John and family. I did ride around in the cruiser with him later that day. As I remember that was the last time, I saw him. He was always working.

I had no idea he lived so near me here in the Hurricane area. I would have loved to see him again and catch up on our lives.

I have some old movies taken of Angie, Tony John and Bobbie which I transferred to video and I will have a copy for both of you.

I plan to visit the funeral home Tuesday as it is within walking distance of my home.
